

Great Pyramid Passages, Book II page 34:

"The date of the creation of Adam, given in the chronological list as 4128 BC, really commenced in Autumn, a quarter of a year earlier, that is, 4128.25 years before 1st. Jan. AD 1. Six thousand years from the creation of Adam, therefore, ended at the date 1872 AD in the Autumn, or 1871.75 years after 1st. Jan. AD 1. (4128.25 + 1871.75 = 6000.)"

The Time Is At Hand, page 51:

"Thus we have found a clear and connected line of chronology from creation to the beginning of the Christian era (AD) — in all, a period of four thousand one hundred and twenty-eight (4128) years, which, together with eighteen hundred and seventy-two years of the Christian era, make six thousand years from creation to the year 1873 AD."

The Time Is At Hand, pages 53 and 54:

"So, then, whereas Usher dates AD 1 as the year 4005 from the creation of Adam, it really was, as we have shown, the year 4129, according to the Bible record, thus showing the year 1872 AD to be the year of the world 6000, and 1873 AD the commencement of the seventh thousand-year period, the seventh millennium, or thousand-year day of earth's history."

The Time Is At Hand, page 67:

"The date of Nehemiah's commission is ordinarily stated to be BC 445. But Dr. Hale's work on chronology (pages 449 and 531) and Dr. Priestlie's treatise on the 'Harmony of the Evangelists' (pages 24 - 38) show this common view to be nine years short, which would give BC 454 as the true date of Nehemiah's commission; and with this date Daniel's prediction (Chapter 9:25), concerning the decree to restore and to build Jerusalem, agrees."

Reprint 5142 (1912):

"There surely is room for slight differences of opinion on this subject and it behooves us to grant each other the widest latitude. The lease of power to the Gentiles may end in October 1914 or in October 1915..."

Reprint 5564 (1914 November):

"We also found that, as far as we can see from the Bible, this date when the kingdom was taken from the last king of David's line, King Zedekiah, was the year 606 BC (We would not say that it was not 605 or 607, but that as nearly as we can tell it was the year 606 BC)..."
