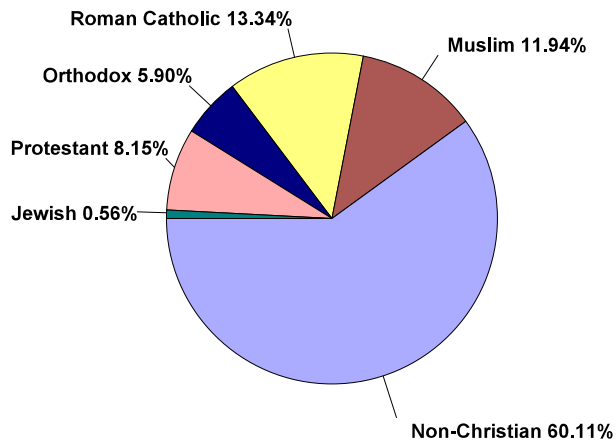


The following tables compare the world population groups in 2012 compared with those of 1886 as reported in volume one, page 16. Jews are a small and diminishing percentage.

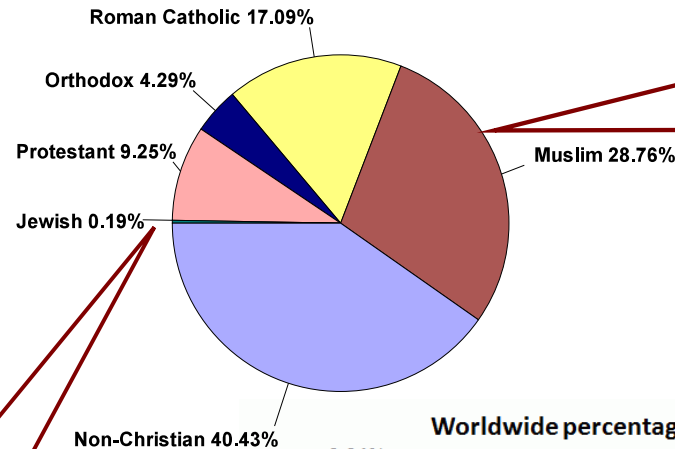
